

Report:

The workshop began with the Inaugural Session **on 23rd November, 2020**. Prof. M. N. Hoda, Director, Bharati Vidyapeeth's Institute of Computer Applications and Management (BVICAM), New Delhi, welcomed all the guests & attendees, and discussed the background note of conducting this Workshop on OBE. II (Case Study) and Design of Outcome based Question Paper and Case Study on NBA SAR Filling ? all three sessions by Prof. Sanjeev Sofat, PEC University, Chandigarh. The last day of the workshop also witnessed a panel discussion on NBA Accreditation by Panel: Prof. Dharmendra Kumar, Prof. P. S. Grover, Prof. Sanjeev Sofat, Prof. H. S. Guruprasad and Prof. M. N. Hoda.

The objective of this workshop was to nurture the philosophy of Outcome Base Education (OBE) and build the capacity of the young Faculty Members, HODs and Directors of the Institutions, so as to facilitate institutionalization in the Teaching Learning System and other Academic Processes of the Institution. During the workshop, the participants were given Assignments based on the sessions and they also underwent a quiz based on MCQ Tests. On the basis of their performance in these assignments and MCQ Tests, they were ranked at A+, A and B categories. The workshop observed active participation from various research
